TTA COVID-19 Rules – Appendix to Park Rules

- Players to follow Touch Football Australia COVID-19 Return-to-Play protocols and guidelines and adopt the **'Get in. Play and Get out'** approach.
- Players, Referee's, Volunteers, and Spectators are not to attend if they are unwell (including any signs/symptoms of cold, flu, COVID-19 or other illness).
- Members who are in the high-risk category should reconsider their participation in Touch Football. (High-risk includes anyone over 70 years of age, have had an organ transplant and are on immune suppressive therapy, have had a bone marrow transplant in the last 24 months, are on immune suppressive therapy for graft versus host disease, have blood cancer within the last 5 years, and having chemotherapy or radiotherapy. - All players, referees, volunteers and spectators are encouraged to download the COVIDSafe App.
- All players are to make themselves aware of the draw via email and/or the website <u>https://tarcuttatouch.weebly.com</u>
- Players are to turn up ready to play and proceed directly to their allocated field.
- Field 1 players are to be on the side line closest to the creek
 Field 2 players are to be on the side line closest to the mobile fuel station
 Field 3 players are to be on the far side line.
- Spectators are to be discourage and are to maintain social distancing (>1.5m). No spectators are to be in the player area.
- A bag with Hand sanitiser, Glen 20, Match Ball, Cones, Squistle, Signage, Score card, pen, Player and Spectator COVID register will be placed on each field.
- The Home team (the team listed first on the draw) will be responsible for sanitising the equipment prior to and at the completion of the match. The procedure as follows:
 - 1. Sanitise Hands.
 - 2. Spray Match Ball, Cones, Squistle, and pen with Glen 20.
 - 3. Sanitise Hands again.
- Home team will also be responsible for completing the COVID register for Players and associated spectators for that field.
- All players are to Hand sanitise prior to the game.
- Do not spit or clear you nasal passages at any time. Cover your mouth to cough or sneeze into your elbow.
- No unnecessary contract with other participants such as high-fives, handshakes and hugs.
- Players can enter the field from anywhere on the side line and should maintain social distancing (>1.5m) while on the sideline.
